sacrifice (sac ri fice). A gift or offering to God.

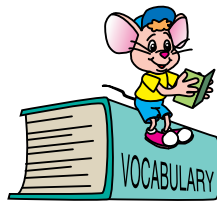
stocks Wooden frames with holes in which to put the hands or feet.
