6. You will be able to tell how God will take care of you.



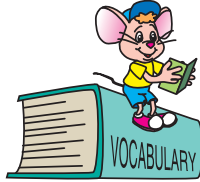
- bless** (bles). To wish well of someone.

- furnace** (fĕr' nis). A closed box in which to make a fire.
- jawbone** (jō' bōn'). The bone that is the lower part of the face.
- pray** (prā). To talk with God.
- priest** (prĕst). A special servant of God.
- prophet** (prof' it). A person who tells what will happen.
- raven** (rā' vun). A big black bird.
- slave** (slāv). A person who is owned by another.
- soul** (sōl). The God-like part of a person.
- sparrow** (spar' ō). A small bird.
- statue** (stach' ü). An image of a person or animal made from wood or stone.
- sword** (sōrd). A long, sharp blade.
- vineyard** (vin' yurd). The place where grapes are grown.
- widow** (wid' ō). A woman whose husband is dead.
- wisdom** (wiz' dum). Knowledge and understanding.
- wise** (wĭz). To know many things.
- worship** (wĕr' ship). To honor God.
