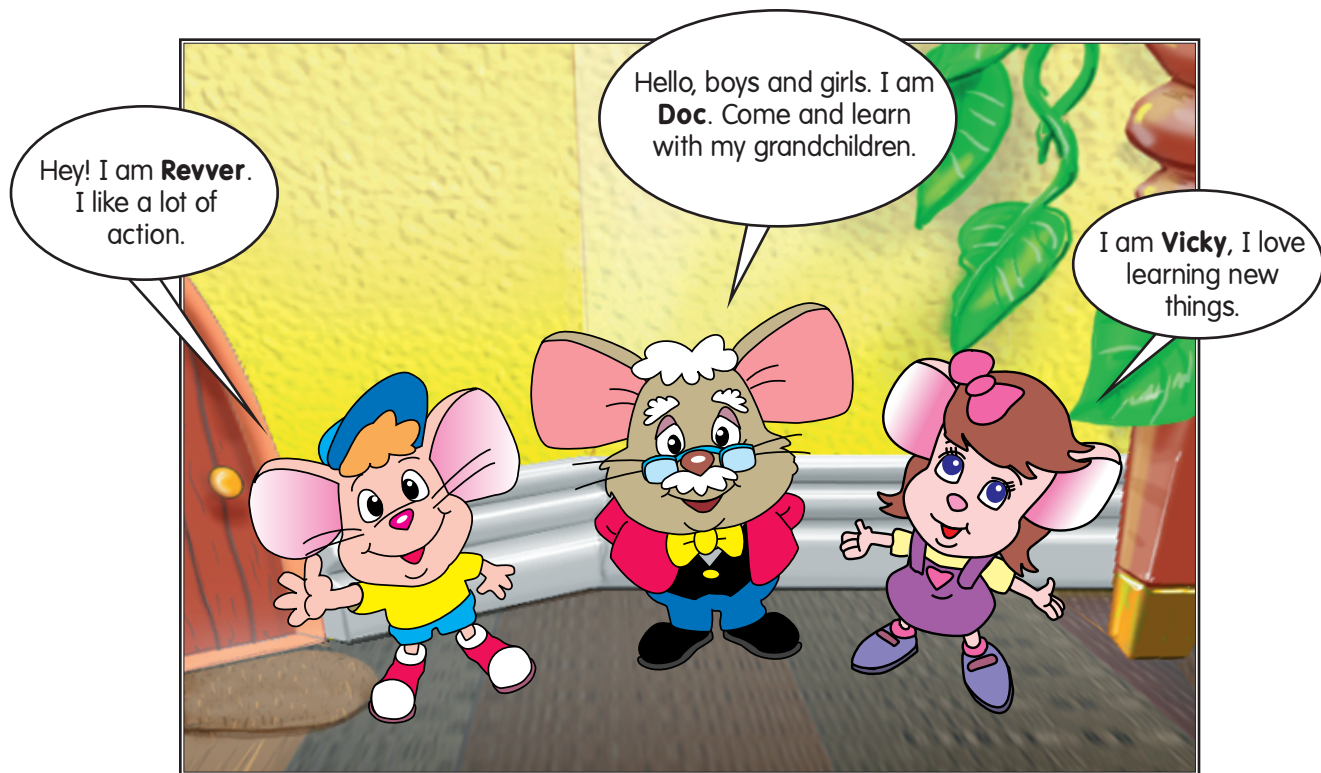

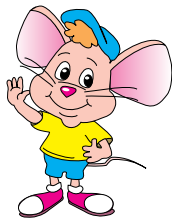

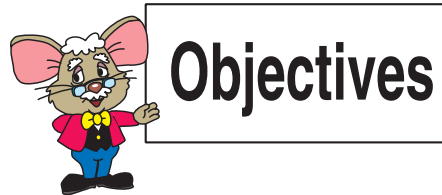

**servants** (sér' vunts). People paid to do work.

**Temple** (tem' pul). The large building King Solomon made for the people to worship God.

**vain** (vān). Lightly; without respect.

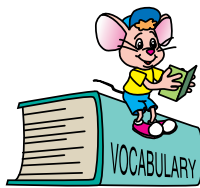
**wisdom** (wiz' dum). Knowing what is right and true.
